I suggest you change the "Position Held" description from

Lawyer, Allen Arthur Robinson Sydney

to

Special Counsel, Allens Arthur Robinson, Sydney **DONE**

Also, in your 100 word statement, I would"

(1) replace "I prepared Business Plan on CD Rom" with "I have prepared a Business Plan"; **NOT DONE, AS THEY WOULD BE MORE LIKELY TO WANT TO LOOK AT MY BUSINESS PLAN IF IT IS ON A CD ROM RATHER THAN PLOUGH THRU A LARGE HARDCOPY. RUDD'S EXPLANATION OF THE SUMMIT IS HE DOESN'T WANT A "Talkfest" SO THEY MIGHT SAY, "Send us your Business Plan which you recently sent to NSW Health and NSW Dept of Environment & Climate Change."**

(2) replace "to enable" with "aimed at enabling"; **DONE**

(3) replace "thereby evidencing living a Local Healthy Lifestyle" with "thereby increasing the proportion of the population living a Local Healthy Lifestyle"; and **I AMENDED TO "thereby increasing Australian living a Local Healthy Lifestyle which leaves a low Carbon Footprint".**

(4) delete the final sentence and replace it with something which links your Business Plan with the 2020 Summit, for example, something along the following lines:

"I would like to participate because my Business Plan addresses 3 of the Critical Areas nominated for consideration by the 2020 Summit."

I AMENDED TO "I sent my Business Plan, which addresses 3 of the 10 Critical Areas, to "NSW Health" & "NSW Environment & Climate Change" in early Feb '08."
